


I also could imagine that we could work with simple forms for example rectangles. Put them together as an architectural piece. That would also give a link to our work on the wall.


Esther Schena, Silkscreen on window, made at praxis seminar on 9th of april 2018:

Dominique: Cool!








Silkscrenn with Vaseline creme. Just try out how fat react and change on different papers.
